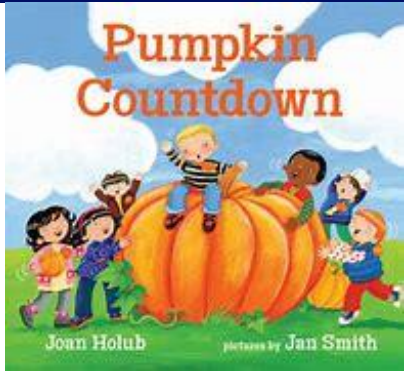

2 Put one arm at a time in the sleeves.




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How to put your coat on
