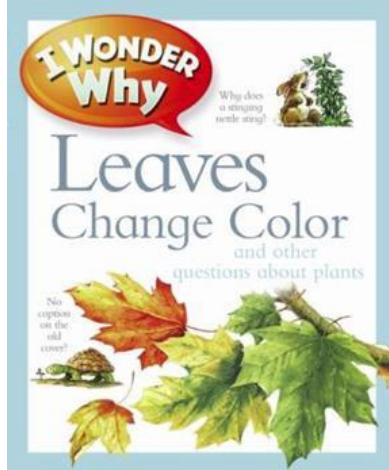
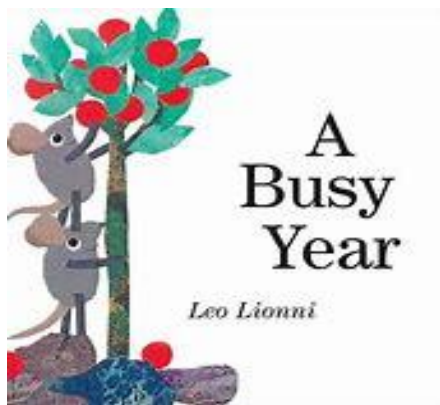

TREE STUDY

"HOW DO TREES CHANGE?"

Hello Families,
Our students learned how trees change. Explaining: "When trees are planted and when they grow from seeds, they are very small. They grow taller every year, just as we do! We know from reading about trees and planting our tree that they need soil, sunlight, and water to grow. Growing taller is one way that trees change." Next, students understand that trees grow and change, just as we do. Trees need food and water, just like us! We are living things, and so are trees. Living things grow and change. Living things need food and water.



Students dug for letters, shapes, and numbers! Play Dirt is an inventive material that looks like loose earth but feels like something from another planet. The super-soft stuff can be packed into shapes and sculptures or simply oozed through your fingers. With a fine texture and a fluffy feel, it's satisfying to just dig your hands into the strange substance.
