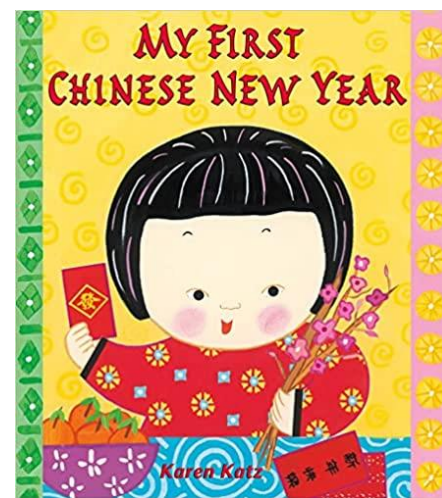
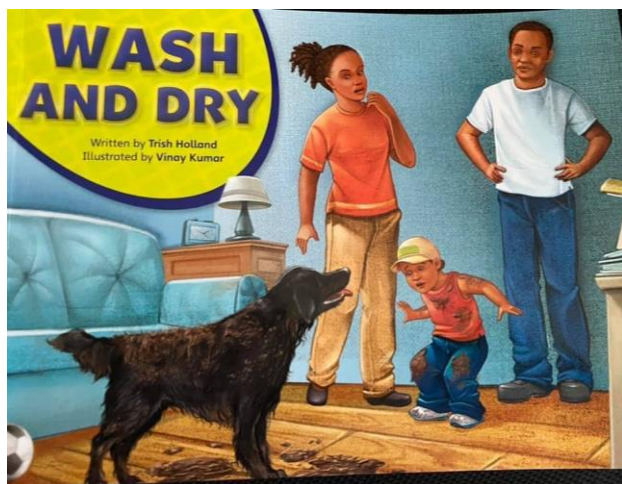

CLOTHES STUDY

HOW DO WE TAKE CARE OF OUR CLOTHES?

Hello Families,

This week students learned the following:

- How to sort clothes clothes by color, before washing them.
- Read Care labels: Check for a soft tag along the inside of your garment—it'll probably have a series of different symbols on it. These shapes suggest the best wash temperature and cycle to use, as well as any other precautions you should take.
- Clean delicate fabrics carefully so they don't get ruined.
- Avoid overloading your dryer.
- Iron specific fabrics at their recommended temperatures.
(Manvir- “Do not leave the hot iron on clothes, because it can burn them and you!”)
- Hang up your clothing with hangers or fold them
- Mend your clothes as needed.
- Purchase a sewing kit for any last-minute repairs. Tears, snags, and rips can pop up when you least expect them. When the time comes, mend your clothes with a sewing needle and a spool of thread that matches your garment.
- Lastly, Peter shared/discussed his adventures in South Africa! We learned about different animals/prints, what clothes you should wear on safari and how to dress during day and night 😊 Students used tribal print to create outfits inspired by his South African trip!



Iron Safety

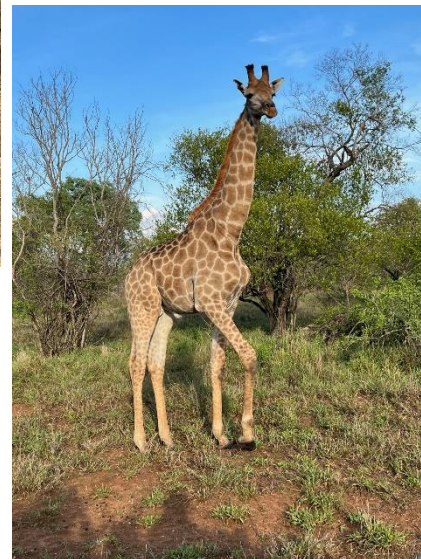
- Did you turn it to 0?
